


DSCSA Compliance



The Drug Supply Chain Security Act (DSCSA) is a set of Federal regulations administered by the FDA to identify and trace certain prescription drugs distributed in the United States in order to increase patient safety, minimize diversion and reduce counterfeiting. The FDA set a November 2017 deadline for companies to meet DSCSA

regulations. WDP is in compliance with current DSCSA requirements. After the deadline passes, brand owners will be held responsible to ensure their products are handled by DSCSA-compliant companies within their pharmaceutical supply chain.

WDP invests significant funds to continually upgrade packaging equipment, labeling equipment and the information technology platform at the Houston, TX manufacturing facility to maintain DSCSA compliance.
